2026 Scholarship Rules

The Red Rock Wildlife Management Association Scholarship is awarded to two (2) high school Seniors totaling \$500 each. Scholarships awarded are based on scholastic achievement, leadership in agriculture, wildlife and natural resource management, civic and community activities, financial need and the ability to contribute to agriculture, wildlife and natural resource management in the future. Scholarship application is available on the RRWMA website.

- Applicant must be a resident of Bastrop or Caldwell County or attend a high school or homeschool in Bastrop or Caldwell County. All applicants must have a relative or a legal guardian that is a member of RRWMA.
- At the time of the application, applicant must be a Senior in high school or the equivalent thereof.
- Your application MUST include:
 - This completed application.
 - A copy of your original high school transcript through mid-term your senior year, including rank and GPA.
 - Minimum 300-word essay regarding your agricultural, wildlife or natural resource influences and goals, involvement in the industry and future goals in life.
- Original Applicant, Parent/Legal Guardian and Counselor signatures are required.

The winning applicant(s) will be paid a one-time award to be used toward tuition or other education related expenses. The scholarship must be accepted in the year that it is won. If this does not occur, the scholarship money will be returned to RRWMA Scholarship fund.

Scholarship winner will be notified and recognized at the RRWMA Fundraiser on May 2, 2026.

Payment of the scholarship will be made by the Scholarship Committee for RRWMA to an accredited college, university or technical school after enrollment. Payment will be made to the selected student's account when RRWMA receives enrollment information from the recipient.
